Establishment of DAP as a permanent programme during Colombo Plan's 23rd Consultative Committee Meeting in New Zealand.









## DAP NETWORKS: Countries with DAP Programmes






### DAP STRATEGY & INNOVATION

- The ITTC Network develops and strengthens the workforce, organizations and systems that provide substance use prevention, treatment, and recovery support services.
- Based in universities and research centers, ITTCs utilize a variety of strategies to accelerate the implementation of scientificallybased and culturally appropriate practices
- DAP works with ITTC Network Coordinating Office in partnership with the International Consortium of Universities on Drug Demand Reduction (ICUDDR).
